## HOW to apply?

- Now through March 31, download a LIHEAP application from the Catholic Charities Energy Assistance

- New Applicants should call the Catholic Charities DEAP office in their county to schedule a "curbside" intake appointment. Complete the LIHEAP application, gather the required documents and bring everything to the appointment.
- Last year's applicants should complete the application, gather the required documents, and submit
  everything to their county Catholic Charities DEAP office by fax, mail, or drop box at one of the

## WHEN will I receive this heating assistance?

- LIHEAP supplemental heating assistance benefits are disbursed to energy vendors of eligible households sometime after October 1st, when funds become available.
- Keep in mind, the program is a federally funded supplemental benefit and not designed to pay for all heating
  costs
